

Outstanding Student Leaders Award 2017-2018

The Hok Yau Club Potential Development Centre has organized the “Outstanding Student Leaders Award 2017-2018” to recognize and award S.4 to S.6 student leaders who have shown remarkable levels of responsibility and contribution to their schools and society. After two rounds of interviews, S.5E Tang Yui Chit was short-listed to be one of the initial thirty two student leaders. After the final round of interviews, he was ultimately selected as one of the ten Outstanding Student Leaders.

The thirty two student leaders who had passed the first two rounds of interviews were invited to attend a series of leadership training programmes from January to May including a 8-day exchange trip. During the programmes, not only did the student leaders have to plan and execute an issue-based project and other society related activities, they also had the opportunity to meet leaders from different areas of Hong Kong and take part in an exchange trip to Shenyang and Harbin to develop a better understanding of Hong Kong and China. Through a string of experiential learning activities, students participating were able to further mature as well as improve their personal and leadership qualities.





近八成受訪中學生從未參與政策諮詢

【本報訊】一項調查顯示，本港中學生參與公共事務的程度較去年低，近八成人從未於政策諮詢中表達意見，而受訪中學生對香港身份認同程度高，全部人皆表示願意為香港出一分力，但同時分別有六至七成人希望在海外或內地置業、升學和工作；調查又顯示，中學生最不喜歡的首兩名政治人物，分別是美國總統特朗普及前特首梁振英。

學友社舉辦「傑出中學生領袖選舉」，選出十名傑出中學生領袖，並向二百八十二名候選中學生進行問卷調查，結果發現，有七成六受訪學生從來沒有於政策諮詢活動中表達意見，六成五人沒有參與選舉事務，各項公共事務的參與度皆比去年稍微下降四至五個百分點。

對香港身份認同甚高

在身份認同方面，受訪學生對香港的身份認同甚高，全部學生皆表示願意為香港出一分力及有責任為香港締造更美好的未來，七成九認為香港跟內地其他城市並不一樣。調查中有近六成學生選擇於香港定居。

於選舉中獲選為傑出學生的李灝表示，現時青少年面對政治有無力感，政府未有回應市民的訴求，因此大家認為參與政治活動的成效不大。
