The New Territories Outstanding Students Selection 2016

In spite of the intense competition among about 1,000 students from 130 secondary schools in New Territories, S.3 WU Yan-yu and YEUNG Yuet-sang have been selected as the Top 10 Outstanding Students in the New Territories with their excellent performances in academic results, leadership, extra-curriculum activities and social services in the Outstanding Students Selection 2016 organized by the Federation of the New Territories Youth and the Federation of Outstanding Students. S.3 CHAN Yi-ting has also been selected as the Outstanding Student in the New Territories in the selection.

The candidates were required to take part in the Outstanding Students Selection organized by the eight districts to which they belong firstly. The top 3 candidates of each district were nominated as the 44 participants/candidates for the New Territories Outstanding Students Selection.

Candidates were then required to make a video, demonstrating their creativity, collaboration skills and leadership skills. They then underwent a written test and group discussion which assess their logical thinking skills, presentation skills and their cognition of social affairs of Hong Kong, the Basic Law and China. Lastly, all participants attended the individual interviews. 5 junior students and 5 senior students stood out from all candidates and were finally selected as the Top 10 Outstanding Students of the New Territories.
