Natural and Human Landscapes and Environmental Conservation in Guilin

Forty of our S.3 students were pleased to visit Guilin from 17th to 20th November under the Mainland Exchange Programme for Junior Secondary and Upper Primary Students held by the “Passing on the Torch” National Education Platform. The program is very much aligned with The National Education Platform’s goal to promote students’ knowledge about ecological conservation and broaden their horizons.

Guilin is the pearl of China on account of its natural beauty and historic treasures. They were also offered the valuable chance to pay a visit to a middle school in which they interacted with local students and experienced school life in Guilin.
