

The 11th Yuen Long District Outstanding Primary School Students Award (2016/2017)

Prize-giving Ceremony

The 11th Yuen Long District Outstanding Primary School Students Award Prize-giving Ceremony was successfully held on 6th May, 2017 at N.T. Heung Yee Kuk Yuen Long District Secondary School. The award was jointly organized by Heung Yee Kuk New Territories, the Alumni Association of N.T. Heung Yee Kuk Yuen Long District Secondary School and N.T. Heung Yee Kuk Yuen Long District Secondary School. For years, Heung Yee Kuk New Territories has been serving and providing opportunities for quality education for the citizens of the New Territories.
