Outstanding Student Leaders Award 2018-2019 (25 May 2019)

The Hok Yau Club Potential Development Centre has organized the "Outstanding Student Leaders Award 2018-2019" to recognize and award S.4 to S.5 student leaders who have shown remarkable levels of responsibility and contribution to their schools and society. After two rounds of interviews, S.5E CHAN Kei-yan, CHAN Lok-yiu and NG Ka-may were shortlisted to be one of the initial thirty one student leaders.
