Our students attained excellent accomplishments in the New Territories Outstanding Students Selection 2021 organised by The Federation of the New Territories Youth. The Chief Executive of the HKSAR, Mrs. Carrie LAM CHENG Yuet-ngor, officiated at The Prize Presentation Ceremony of the “New Territories Outstanding Students Selection 2021” on 30 October 2021. The award aims to give recognition to outstanding students, encouraging them to have positive influence on peers and motivate them for lifelong learning and active participation in social services.

This year, more than 1100 contestants from 150 secondary schools, which is close to 70% of the total number of secondary schools in the New Territories, participated in the outstanding students selection. The top 3 outstanding students of each of the 8 districts across the territory were nominated as the 46 candidates for the New Territories Outstanding Students Selection 2021.

Candidates were required to take a written test, in which their logical thinking skills, communication skills and their awareness of community and national affairs were assessed. They were then required to make a video in groups, demonstrating their creativity, team spirit and leadership skills. After rounds of individual and group interviews, LAU Yee outshone all other candidates and got the Top 10 New Territories Outstanding Student Award.
