To deepen students’ knowledge of Xi Jinping’s Thoughts on the Rule of Law and to implement the spirit of General Secretary Xi Jinping’s instructions on study, publicity and education of the Constitution, the 6th National Students “Learn the Constitution Speak the Constitution” Activity Grand Final, jointly organized by the Ministry of Education of the People’s Republic of China and Beijing Foreign Studies University (The National Youth Rule of Law Education Center) kicked off on 27 November 2021. The contest was held in accordance with the Notice on Organizing and Carrying Out Constitution Study, Publicity and Education Activities to popularise constitutional knowledge, promote constitutional spirit and establish constitutional authority among the youth. The Grand Final officially started on 28 November 2021 and was conducted in two main modes: Speech Contest and Knowledge Contest. The 3-day Speech Contest was conducted in two phases: Keynote Speech and Propositional Speech. 147 contestants from 31 provinces, regions and cities shared their stories of learning the Constitution via the online contest, expressing their understanding of the Constitution and the rule of law from the perspective of the youth.

Tsz-ling had excellent performance in the Speech Contest in the first round (Keynote Speech) and outshone other contestants in the second round (Propositional Speech), and was eventually awarded the First Prize and the Best Delivery Award.
