The 50th Speech Day

Officiating Guest of Honour Mr. Kevin YEUNG Yun-hung, JP, Secretary for Education, presented prizes to students of N.T. Heung Yee Kuk Yuen Long District Secondary School and encouraged students to uphold the school motto and contribute to society (17th December 2021)

The 50th Speech Day of N.T. Heung Yee Kuk Yuen Long District Secondary School was successfully held at our School Hall on 17th December 2021. We were honoured to have invited Mr. Kevin YEUNG Yun-hung, JP, Secretary for Education to be the Guest of Honour to address us and present prizes to our outstanding students. We also had the pleasure of the presence of honourable Mr. Kenneth LAU Ip-keung, BBS, MH, JP, Chairman of the School Council, Ms. Vickie LI Wai-bing, Chairperson of the School Management Committee, members of the School Council and the School Management Committee, parents as well as representatives of the Alumni Association.

The proceedings commenced at 10:30 a.m. in the morning with a solemn National Flag Raising Ceremony in which the national anthem was played and respectfully sung by all attendees. After that, the Annual School Report was presented by Principal YUEN. Principal YUEN reported that our school has been closely following the "Health Protection Measures for School" issued by the Education Bureau to safeguard students' health while 70% of the teachers, staff and students have been vaccinated, making the school eligible for the resumption of whole-day face-to-face classes.

To cultivate students' patriotic sentiments and sense of national identity, our school has actively and successfully participated in various National Education activities organized by the Education Bureau: our school was the 2nd Runner-up (Secondary School Group) in the School Bulletin Board Design Competition on National Security and was awarded "The Most Active Participation" in the "2020 National Constitution Day Online Competition", the "2021 National Security Education Day Online Quiz Competition", and the "7th Territory-wide Inter-school Basic Law Competition". Besides, Heung Chung students have been highly acclaimed for their remarkable accomplishments in both academic and extra-curricular activities. Our students got excellent results in the 2021 HKDSE Examination, with a total haul of 56 Level 5**. They attained 74.4 % Level 4 and above and 40.7% Level 5 and above in the total number of subjects sat. This marks the best-ever results for the school. 85.7% of students met the requirements to be eligible for university admission. CHAN Ho-hin, attained the most outstanding result – Level 5** in five subjects, Level 5* in two subjects and Level 5 in one subject – and was admitted to the School of Science of The University of Hong Kong with the title "President's

Scholar". LIN Ruying Maggie attained Level 5** in 5 subjects and Level 5* in 2 subjects; FUNG Kwun-kei attained Level 5** in 5 subjects, Level 5* in one subject; CHAU Yau-lam and LI Suet-man attained Level 5** in 3 subjects and Level 5* in 2 subjects; HO Annie and CHOW Chun-yin attained Level 5** in two subjects and Level 5* in 4 subjects; LO Yan-chit and TANG Tsz-yau both attained Level 5** in two subjects and Level 5* in 3 subjects; NG Cheuk-yi, CHEUNG Pak-ho and LAU Ka-yuet attained Level 5** in two subjects and Level 5** in two subjects; CHAN Wang-chit Philemon, KWAN Yan-ting, SHIU Yan-kiu, HUNG Tsz-hong and NG Sheung-lai attained Level 5** in one subject and Level 5* in three subjects.

Heung Chung has put great emphasis on students' whole-person development, aiming to cultivate students' positive values and attitudes through an array of activities aligning with the theme, "Be Grateful, Be Proactive, Be Positive". Our students shone and achieved excellence in various aspects. In the 15th Yuen Long District Outstanding Students Selection, 3D WONG Ching-hong, YUNG Hiu-shun, FONG Lok-yin and WONG Ying-chun Gladys were respectively selected Champion, 1st Runner-up, and 2nd Runner-up and in the Yuen Long District Top Ten Outstanding Student in the Junior Form Category; 5E YU Tung-ching and 4E CHAN Hoi-yi were Champion and 1st Runner-up respectively in the same competition. Nominated for the New Territories Outstanding Students Selection, YU Tung-ching was selected as one of the Top Ten New Territories Outstanding Students. YU was also selected as one of the Top 5 Outstanding Student Leaders in the 6th Outstanding Student Leaders Selection organized by The Arete, one of the Top Ten Outstanding Student Leaders in the Outstanding Student Leaders Award 2020-2021 and one of the 20 "Hong Kong Outstanding Teens" in the 2021 Hong Kong Outstanding Teens Election; 5A NG Po-sin was the 1st Runner-up in the Yuen Long District Outstanding Volunteer Election 2020; 5E WONG Pak-ching, Janice was selected as one of the Top 20 Outstanding Students in the 33rd Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Outstanding Students Selection; 6E YICK Chau-ho was shortlisted as one of the twelve finalists in the category of Performing Artist in Student of the Year Award 2020/21, 6E CHAN Ho-hin was selected as one of the Top 10 Hong Kong Outstanding Students in the Hong Kong Outstanding Students Award. Our 2020 graduates CHAN Lok-yiu and TIU Tsz-ching won the Grantham Scholars of the Year Award 2020-21. For biliteracy and trilingualism, 3D WONG Ying-chun, Gladys won the 1st Runner-up and the Best Impromptu Speaker Award in the "21st Century Cup" National English Speaking Competition (Hong Kong Region) Junior Secondary Category Grand Final; she was also the 2nd Runner-up in the HKFYG English Public Speaking Contest 2021. 5E YU Tung-ching was selected as the Winner of the 2021 Essay Award in the 2021 Harvard Book Prize programme. Our English Debating Team won its 5th consecutive Championship in the 11th Inter-Government Secondary Schools Debating Competition. 2D NG Kai-yui, 3C FUNG Ngai-tung, and 3D CHEUNG Cheuk-nok won the Championship, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively in the Civic Education Writing Competition. As for Maths and Science, our school was awarded 1st Runner-up in the Secondary School Category and several individual prizes in the Thailand International Mathematical Olympiad 2020-21, in which 5E MA Yixuan was the Champion in the Senior Secondary Category and received a Gold Award in the Final. In the 38th Hong Kong Mathematics Olympiad, our school was the New Territories Regional Winner and 5E MA Yixuan got the Overall Best Performance Award. Our students also attained remarkable results in different Mathematics competitions including 2020 Xiwanbei International Mathematics Contest Final and the Asia International Mathematical Olympiad Open Contest.

Mr. Kevin YEUNG Yun-hung, JP, Secretary for Education presented prizes to all outstanding prize-winners and gave us an inspiring speech. He appreciated the concerted efforts made by all teaching staff in nurturing our students to be responsible and proactive citizens through whole-person development, contributing to the outstanding performance of our students. He also thanked our school for loaning the school premises as Community Testing Centres and arranging vaccination services by coordinating with other government schools in the hopes of safeguarding students' health and creating a safe and wholesome learning environment. Mr. YEUNG encouraged all students to live up to the school motto, uphold positive values, lay a strong foundation, strive for advancement and contribute to society by being law-abiding citizens who respect the rule of law with a sense of social responsibility and national identity, with an affection for Hong Kong as well as an international perspective. At last, Mr. YEUNG appealed to all attendants to cast their votes to fulfil their civic responsibilities on LegCo Election.

We were then honoured to have Mr. Kenneth LAU Ip-keung, BBS, MH, JP, Chairman of the School Council present the Long Service Award to committed teaching staff for their unremitting devotion and contribution to nurturing our students. This was followed by a vote of thanks and student performances. The Chinese Orchestra played "The Song of Harvest" while the Philharmonic Orchestra played the String Trio in G Minor; the former has a fast tempo, demonstrating the joy and delight brought by a bumper harvest, the latter delivered a lyrical and melodious vibe. The Speech Day ended in the singing of the School Song.
