The Awards aim to recognise all-round academic performance and outstanding achievements of secondary school students, and acknowledge their contributions to society:

5E CHAN Hoi-yi, Head Prefect of this school year, has always been an exemplary student, devoted herself to serving her fellow schoolmates. She was the First Runner-up (Senior Group) in the 15<sup>th</sup> Yuen Long District Outstanding Students Selection 2020 and Outstanding Student in the New Territories Outstanding Students Selection 2020. She participated in the “Be a Government Official for a Day” Programme launched by the ‘Life Buddies’ Mentoring Scheme in which she job-shadowed Mr WONG Kam-sing, the former Secretary for the Environment and had a better understanding of the environmental protection programmes in Hong Kong. She also shared her experience with her fellow schoolmates, encouraging them to develop positive thinking and values and make an effort to protect the environment.

4E WONG Ying-chun Gladys has great proficiency in English Language. She was the Second Runner-up in the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups English Public Speaking Contest 2021, and the First Runner-up and Best Impromptu Speaker in the “21st Century Cup” National English Speaking Competition (Hong Kong Region) Junior Secondary Category Grand Final; she won the Second Prize in the 19<sup>th</sup> China Daily “21st Century-Xueersi Cup” National Junior High School English Speaking Grand Final. Gladys also has a great zeal in English debating. She teamed up with her teammates and was the Champion five consecutive times in the Inter-Government Schools English Debating Competition.

6E Fu Jia-cheng Charles has won numerous prizes in various large-scale Mathematics Competitions, including the Gold Award in the Preliminary Round of the 2020-2021 Thailand International Mathematical Olympiad (Hong Kong Region) and the Silver Award in the Hong Kong International Mathematical Olympiad 2021 (Hong Kong Region). Charles joined the Enrichment Programme for Young Mathematics Talents 2021 (Introduction to Discrete Mathematics) organised by The Chinese University of Hong Kong and was awarded Distinction, Industrious Performance Award and Excellent Performance Award.
