

Beijing Study Tour
(2 July – 6 July 2024)

From 2 July 2024 (Tuesday) to 6 July 2024 (Saturday), 40 S3-S5 students, accompanied by Ms. LEUNG Nga-yi, Mr. LAM Fai-chun, Mr. PAN Xubin and Ms. LO Fung-mei, went on the Beijing Study Tour. They visited historical and cultural sites including Tiananmen Square, Juyongguan Great Wall, Summer Palace, Yuanmingyuan, Palace Museum, and the China National Arts and Crafts Museum. They also visited newly developed areas and technological facilities, such as Shougang Park, the Bird's Nest, the Water Cube, the Ice Ribbon, and other Olympic venues, and toured Zhongguancun Science City, the China Aviation Museum, and Zhongguancun Intelligent Manufacturing Street. The five-day itinerary has enriched our students' knowledge about the history, culture, and latest developments of the Mainland, and has enhanced their sense of national identity.
