Mainland Study Tour of the Senior Secondary Subject of Citizenship and Social Development

In order to enable students to gain a better understanding of our Motherland's history, culture and latest development, as well as to cultivate a sense of national identity and patriotism, our school participated in the Study Tour of the Senior Secondary Subject of Citizenship and Social Development (CS) organized by the Education Bureau from 15 November (Friday) to 16 November 2024 (Saturday). 129 S.5 students were accompanied by the Assistant Principal, Ms. KWAN Ki-shun and 12 teachers to visit Zhuhai and Zhongshan.
