6D ZHONG Anruo took part in The Hong Kong Youth Chinese Essay Writing Competition (2024-25), organised by the Hong Kong Youth Cultural & Arts Competitions Committee, together with the Rotary Club of Hong Kong Island West and sponsored by the Home Affairs Department. She delivered an excellent performance and was honoured with the **Merit Award (Senior Secondary Division)**.

The competition aims to deepen young people's interest in and knowledge of the Chinese language, culture, academic studies and the arts through contest participation, thereby raising their standards and actively promoting traditional Chinese culture.

6D ZHONG Anruo wrote a science-fiction micro-story that explores how, in an age dominated by artificial-intelligence technology, the right to define the concept of happiness is being reshaped for the individual, as well as the tensions that arise between technological optimisation and humanity's ways of pursuing happiness. The work is creatively conceived and deeply affecting.
