

The United Kingdom Study Tour

(24 June – 4 July 2026)

An 11-day United Kingdom Study Tour was organized for 20 S1 to S3 students from 24 June 2026 (Wednesday) to 4 July 2026 (Saturday). Students were accompanied by Ms. LO Wing-yee and Mr. YUEN Chun-wai as they visited London and other neighboring cities.

The UK study tour connected students with local residents to explore Britain's history, culture, and technology across a wide array of iconic destinations. Following their arrival at London Heathrow Airport, students visited historic landmarks including Windsor Castle, Buckingham Palace, Downing Street, Westminster Abbey, Big Ben, and Tower Bridge. Their journey through Britain's heritage continued with trips to Shakespeare's Birthplace, Stonehenge, the Roman Baths, and the British Museum. Students also experienced the academic prestige of the University of Oxford – including the Bodleian Library – and the University of Cambridge. To round out their exploration of contemporary culture and innovation, participants visited the London Transport Museum, Kew Gardens, the Warner Bros. Studio Tour, the Wembley Stadium, and the London Eye, alongside taking a River Thames cruise and watching a mesmerizing performance of the Phantom of the Opera.

Observing Britain's blend of history and modernity inspired students to reflect deeply on China's own ancient civilization and dynamic progress. This comparison fostered a profound appreciation for their heritage, empowering them to balance a strong national identity with a global perspective. They emerged as cross-cultural ambassadors, proud of their Chinese roots and ready to engage the world respectfully.

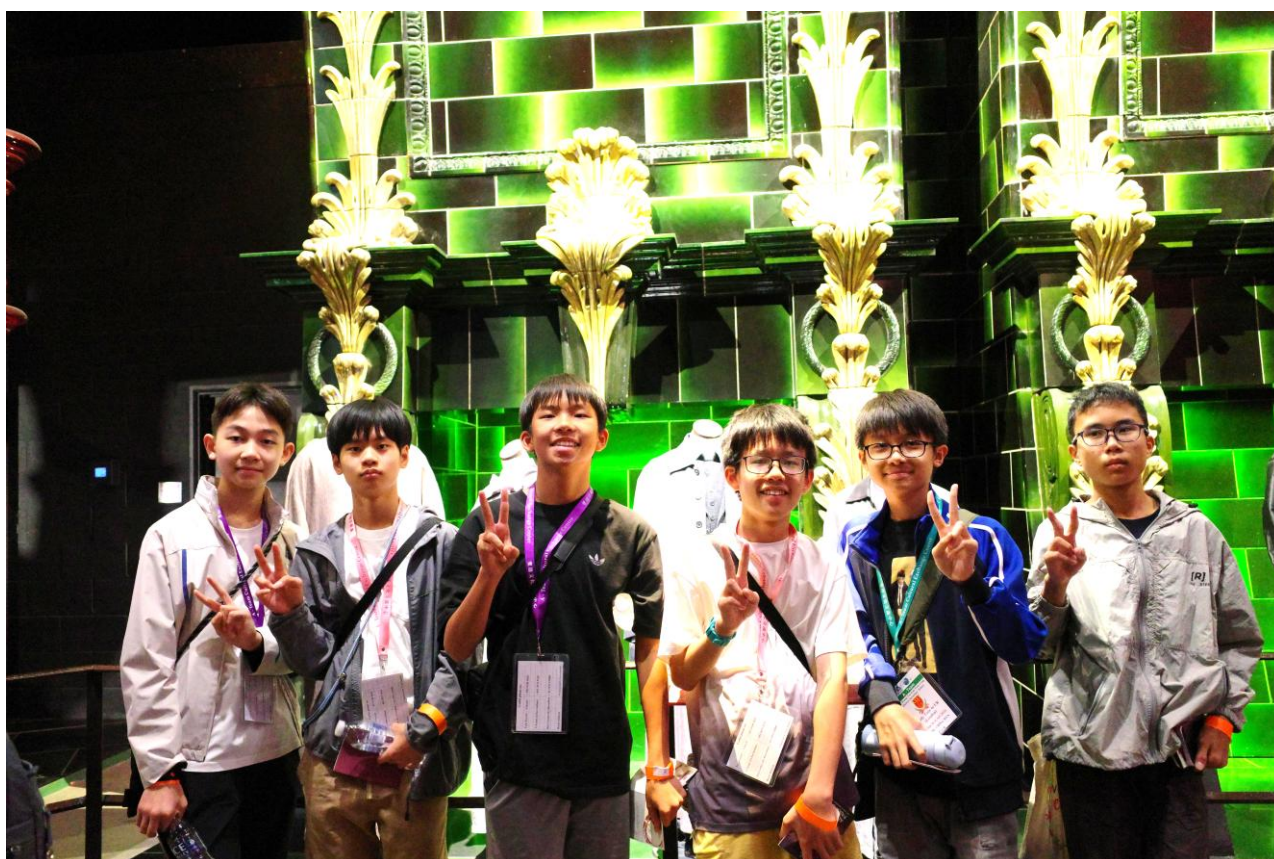
