In the Citizenship and Social Development Online Reading Award Scheme 2025/26, our school was awarded the **Most Active Participating School Award** and the **Outstanding Performance Award** in recognition of our students' enthusiastic participation and excellent performance.

In the Citizenship and Social Development Thematic Reading Report Competition 2025/26, two groups of students were honoured for their creative and impressive presentations of their reading experiences. In addition, the 'Interactive Game' project, created by **4E CHEUNG Wai-yau Norelle, 4E LAU Jeanne Kieu, 4E LIN Tsz-ki and 4E WONG Ho-kiu**, was awarded the **Merit Award**. The students demonstrated creativity and innovation by incorporating interactive elements and technology into their presentation of reading insights and learning outcomes.

The Citizenship and Social Development Online Reading Award Scheme and Thematic Reading Report Competition 2025/26 aims to enhance students' interest in reading through diversified reading materials and creative activities. It encourages students to develop a deeper understanding of the development of the Nation and Hong Kong, as well as important issues such as national security. The programme also seeks to strengthen students' sense of national identity and belonging, while nurturing a new generation of citizens with critical thinking skills, social responsibility, a strong sense of national awareness and a global perspective. Through reading, research and creative presentations, students not only deepened their understanding of Citizenship and Social Development, but also enhanced their collaboration, communication and digital technology skills.
